Open windows at least 20 minutes before cleaning to allow fresh air to circulate throughout the room. Leave windows open during the entire cleaning process.

Wash Hands Before & After Cleaning

Scrub your hands with a disinfectant soap for a minimum of 20 seconds. Make sure to scrub the front and back of your hands, as well as under your fingernails. If adequate soap is not supplied, use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.

Use Disposable Products and/or Wash Cleaning Products According to Guidelines

It is important to use different cleaning products (rags, paper towels, etc.) between surfaces to reduce the potential spread of infection. If using reusable cleaning products, machine-wash them at highest heat setting for the material and always use a different rag on different surfaces.

Clean First, Disinfect Second

Cleaning is the process of removing dirt, germs, and other particles on a surface. Disinfecting is the process of killing all germs by use of bleach and/or cleaning ingredients with alcohol. Doing both, in this order, is the best way to reduce the chance of spreading or contracting infection.



Use the Correct Disinfectant

Based on findings from the WHO and CDC, the following solutions are acceptable disinfectants against COVID-19:

- Diluted bleach solutions
- Products with at least 70% alcohol
- Common disinfectants registered by the Environmental Protection Agency

Clean ALL Surfaces, with Special Focus on Frequently Touched Surfaces

Most frequently touched surfaces tend to be: light switches, doorknobs and handles, remotes, faucets, refrigerator, and more.

Don't Forget the Floors and Fabrics

It is important to make sure all dirt, grime, and other germs are removed from the floors, carpets, rugs, drapes, duvet covers, and more. If necessary, machine-wash these items at their highest allowed heat setting.

Wash ALL Towels & Linens at the Highest Recommended Heat by the Manufacturer

This includes bath towels, hand towels, face towels, pool towels, bedspreads, blankets, sheets, duvet covers, and pillowcases.



Clean and Disinfect ALL Cleaning Supplies & Laundry Baskets

Remove liners from laundry baskets and machine-wash after every use. Additionally, make sure and spray all cleaning products down with a disinfectant after every use.
